The Dallas Division of the FBI has investigative jurisdiction covering an area of 120,753 square miles. Included within this area is 132 of 254 counties in Texas. The area is bordered by New Mexico, Oklahoma, Arkansas, and Louisiana, and in Texas by the Houston, San Antonio and El Paso Divisions of the FBI. Principal cities in the Dallas Division include Dallas, Fort Worth, Amarillo, Lubbock, Wichita Falls, Paris, Tyler, Longview, Texarkana, Arlington, Grand Prairie, Mesquite, Richardson, and Irving, Texas.

I. MAJOR OPERATING RACKETS

Information obtained from reliable and trustworthy sources of information, and investigation by the Dallas Division in recent months continues to indicate gambling is the only form of crime that could be considered a major racket in the Dallas Division. Gambling continues to thrive in the Dallas, Fort Worth, Amarillo and Lubbock areas. Although gambling in the period from March 1 through September 1, 1963, has come under extreme pressure and harassment from law enforcement agencies, local, state and Federal, acting jointly, it continues to thrive.
