

There certainly is reason to believe that GEMBERLING was making reference to the OSWALD letter in question;

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GEMBERLING of course would be a very logical person to interview; however, he had a heart attack approximately a month ago and try as we did, we were unable to get clearance from his doctor who is out of town, to interview GEMBERLING. Interestingly, I called SA GEMBERLING and told him in the absence of a doctor's clearance, we did not intend to interview him. He responded that he was willing but understood the Bureau's point of view. He volunteered that he really had nothing to add and mentioned specifically that the OSWALD letter would have enhanced his assassination report since it would have tended to prove the dangerous propensities of OSWALD. GEMBERLING knows that he possibly will be interviewed on some future occasion but the very fact that he volunteered that he had little to add would tend to indicate that the interview would be negative.

For the Director's informaton, on Sunday, August 3], the source telephonically contacted MR. ADAMS to advise that he had received an anonymous phone call from a female at 10:50 a.m. This female, articulate in voice and being coached by a male in the background, advised that she was a person who knew a great deal about the OSWALD note. This person advised that HOSTY destroyed the note on specific orders - - instructions from HOWE, that GEMBERLING knew about the note and saw it, and that URAL HORTON and BILL ANDERTON knew about it. At 12:02 p.m. on the same date, the source received another phone call, probably from the same woman, and furnished the street of residence of those agents previously mentioned who currently live in Dallas, as well as the location of HOSTY and HOWE. Interestingly, the female with regard to HOWE stated he is in San Francisco and had been in Seattle; but the man in the background corrected her saying no, San Diego (which is the correct information)
