Dear Mr. Wilson:

I am writing about my FOIA request of 17 March 1976, for CIA material given to the Rockefeller Commission in connection with the allegations made in my memo of 24 March 1975, on the CIA and the Warren Commission investigation. I have not yet received any documents in response to that request.

In my letter of 16 May 1976, I specified that CIA items 1082 through 1092, and especially #1088, seemed to be covered by my request. (These items were described in a list of withheld documents which you sent to Mr. Bernard Fensterwald.)

In your letter of 13 July 1976, you indicated that the material I had asked for was covered by the systematic review you were conducting for Mr. Fensterwald.

Mr. Fensterwald has sent me your letters to him of 19 January and 14 March 1977, and pages 1-281 of the Document Disposition Index. From this material, it is not clear to me whether the re-review was set up to cover all of the items which you had previously described for him as withheld (items 522 through 1129).

Specifically, the Document Disposition Index suggests that items 1082 through 1092 have not yet been reexamined. I would like to make sure that these eleven items will be reviewed in response to my specific request.

Mr. Fensterwald's request seems to have been restricted to the 201 file on Oswald, and to files on certain additional named persons. Your initial release (in March 1976) also covered files identified as "DDO, OGC, SIG, OS, Station, DDI, and Nosenko." Many of the documents originally numbered 1004 through 1129 (and withheld) appear to be from these additional files. The Document Disposition Index indicates that only a few of these items have been re-reviewed.

Could you clarify the status of items 1004 through 1129? If they are not already being reviewed for Mr. Fensterwald, I would like to have them reviewed for me.

I would, of course, also appreciate prompt action on items 1082 through 1092, since my request has now been pending for a full year.
