Dear Mr. Hoch:

In response to your letter of 3 April 1977 concerning your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request for CIA records related to the investigation of the assassination of President Kennedy, the Agency's re-review of the records is still in progress. The re-review of documents responsive to Mr. Fensterwald's request is, as you surmise, completed. The re-review, however, will continue until all records pertinent to the other FOIA requests have been attended to. The documents previously numbered as 1082 through 1092 which have not yet been included in the re-review will be. A number of the documents in the group you identified as 1004 through 1129 have been re-reviewed and a number released on 19 April 1977. The documents treated are those earlier numbered 1004 through 1061, 1068 through 1069 and 1126 through 1029. That group of documents has been labeled, for convenience, as Batch "F". That batch consists of 84 documents or 220 pages; available at the standard reproduction fee of ten cents a page. The cost to you would be \$10.30 for the new or previously denied documents.

As noted above, the re-review is continuing and will shortly be finished. I expect that one more batch of released documents will be available and will notify you when they are available. That batch will include any releasable versions of the documents you have indicated an interest in.
