NOTICE OF FILING

Defendant, by its undersigned attorneys, hereby submits the Declaration of Louis J. Dube and accompanying document description index for the documents originally numbered 1004-1129. These documents were at issue in Fensterwald v. CIA, Civil No. 75-897 (D.D.C. July 18, 1978), vacated on procedural grounds, (D.D.C. July 28, 1978), and also fall within the scope of the instant action. Throughout this litigation, plaintiff has repeatedly sought justification for their continued withholding. Accordingly, defendant, in the interest of administrative and judicial economy, agreed to provide the affidavit and document description index filed in Fensterwald and a current declaration attesting to the continued viability of the exemptions claimed. See Defendant's Response To Plaintiff's Motion For Partial Reconsideration, filed August 31, 1984, at 2.¹
