

JFK Assassination - Six photographs

Dear Sirs:

On May 3 of this year (see attached letter ) I made request from the Federal Bureau of Investigation for copies of photographs pertaining to the President Kennedy assassination. I was informed by the Bureau that they were unable to determine the existence of the photographs in their files (see attached letters dated June 18, 1980 and July 9, 1980). In the Bureau's last correspondence they stated that the photographs appear to be the property of the Central Intelligence Agency but gave no basis for their determination.

I hereby respectfully appeal this determination and request that a further search be conducted as to the existence, identity and location of these photographs.
