Dear Mr. Shaw:

This responds to your letter dated October 20, 1980, concerning your Freedom of Information Act request directed to the Federal Bureau of Investigation.

On October 24, 1979, you requested access to the album of photos of participants in the Quebec-Washington-Guantanamo Walk for Peace, which was referred to in Warren Commission Document #729. You were informed by this Office on March 31, 1980, that the photographs are currently classified and have been referred to the Department Review Committee for its determination whether continued classification is appropriate. You will be notified of the Committee's decision if it results in the declassification of any information. If in fact you intended to request access to Document #729 in its entirety, rather than just the photographs, you should contact the F.B.I. which will respond directly to your request. This Office will consider an appeal from the Bureau's action only on materials other than the photographs.
