## DECLARATION OF BRIAN SCOTT KINSEY

I, Brian Scott Kinsey, make the following declaration based on my personal knowledge.

- assigned to the Freedom of Information-Privacy Acts (FOIPA)
  Section, Records Management Division, Federal Bureau of
  Investigation Headquarters (FBIHQ), Washington, D.C. I have
  been employed as an MDE in the FOIPA Section since April,
  1977, assigned to the processing of FOIPA requests, including
  requests for records pertaining to the assassination of
  President John F. Kennedy.
- (2) Several years ago, MDE Willis A. Newton requested my assistance in the disposal of two duplicate sets of Kennedy assassination materials.

- (3) I assisted MDE Newton in discarding the two duplicate sets of documents by placing portions of them in trash receptacles at FBIHQ. I was aware that an identical copy was maintained in the FOIPA Reading Room and that several copies had been released to the public.
- (4) Because my actions involved only the disposal of unneeded copies of material already available to the public, no record of any kind was prepared by me, or to my knowledge anyone else.

I have read the foregoing statement consisting of two pages. In accordance with 28 U.S.C. 1746, I declare under penalty of perjury that the foregoing is true and correct.
