In response to my request for all records pertaining to the abrogation of the fee waiver I received, from both Civil and FBI, copies of your 3/27/80 to Salochin

re Flanders' memo of 3/4. This is the memo in which you said that I had been lied to, etc., and that the judge also wasn't always told the truth. At one point you say of me, "He has heaped so much vilification on the FBI and Civil Division -- a considerable part of which has not been accurate and some of which has been unfair -- that the processing of his efforts to obtain these records has almost become an 'us' or 'him' exercise."

If you can now recall any instances, I'd like to know. If there is any kind of list of them, I'd like my records to reflect any correction that might be necessary.

I realize that with the passing of time this may have become indistinct.

Frankly, I believe it is impossible to vilify people who behaved as they did and do. I don't think it is vilification to call a liar a liar, for example.

Unfairness is always a possibility, as is inaccuracy. But I'm not aware of either. I was neither to Beckwith, who phoned records, lied under oath and was, all in all, as deceptive, misleading and misinforming as he could be. No matter how much nicer he was with you.

Sorry the paper ~~XXXX~~ was loose above. The copies I got had the entire text obliterated. 100%, that is. But the FBI just attached it to an affidavit in a case of Mark Allen's, with no excisions. This is how I know what you said and for the most part appreciate very much.

No matter how badly all those people behaved and behave I did not and do not want to be unfair or inaccurate. So far as any opinions are concerned, I have low opinions of them and their conduct. And they did combine to waste a major part of my life and productivity.

Hope you are all OK and that you like th new job. We are OK. "il is just about over a sprained ankle and I've been putting on weight from an undiminished appetite and only limited ways of burning calories up. My physical capabilities haven't increased much.

Judge Green mentioned you in that "ark Allen case. I enclose those pages. DJ counsel didn't even bother to tell her you were no longer FOIRA appeals.

She also ordered that Civil pay for the consultancy and held that we substantially prevailed. They moved for reconsideration and she put them down with a bit more force. I suppose they'll appeal now, which runs up the stats and bleeds us more. But if they do it just can kick back and I'm making preparations to help it. We've now got that memo of yours, thanks to the FBI's stupidity, as proof pretty positive of bad faith, which I've alleged often enough. They also managed to lie to her in the last thing they filed, and I'll address that with proofs. So maybe it will be interesting and perhaps even rewarding.
