Dear Mr. Lynch,

I'm sorry that in haste I forgot to enclose the Stanton decision. Ordinarily I do not mail anything on weekends because nobody works in the post office for the entire zip code area except a caretaker, who merely forwards all mail, even local mail, to Baltimore, when it returns Monday or goes out from there. Baltimore is one of the worst post offices. They even steal cookies that are mailed, and mess much up. When I phoned to learn if there is any pickup Saturday afternoons at country boxes and the caretaker didn't know I asked when the last mail left there and he didn't even know that, so I dropped everything and drove into town to mail it immediately.

I think I also forgot to tell you that I'd sent a copy to Jim in the event you want to discuss any of it with him.

Since returning I've found some of the things I referred to in the first memo. I'll send copies, with an explanation, tomorrow. ^Uespite Baltimore.
