Shea will not lie. I have and have had many disagreements with him but I regard him as an honest man. He will be going after the "task force" records for me as part of the appeal I filed some time ago. He is a history buff and recognizes the historical importances involved.

The person in his office who now is most familiar with JFK records is Phyllis Hubbell, a lawyer.

We have a status call Tuesday in the JFK field offices case. I expect that just minutes before it there will be major concessions as a result of administrative procedures. It will mean that there will be searches for other records, among other things.

Remember that at the time in question that FBI division was known as "Crime Records" and that its records have not been searched.
