State of Louisiana v. Dean Andrews

SA Regis Kennedy of the FBI appeared under subpoena last Friday during the course of the trial. He was on the stand for less than five minutes according to the representatives of the U. S. Attorney's office who accompanied him. We do not have a transcript but the AUSA made notes indicating the following questions were asked:

1) Did you interview Dean Andrews in 1963?

Yes.

2) More than once?

Yes.

3) When did the interviews take place?

November 25 and December 11, 1963.

4) Did Dean Andrews mention Clay Bertrand?

Objection. Sustained.

5) Did the name of Clay Bertrand come up in the interviews?

Yes.

6) Subsequent to the interviews, did the FBI seek to locate Clay Bertrand?

Yes.
