REDDING stated that the reason for his inquiry was to try to determine if the had actually furnished any information or whether he was known to the New Orleans Office, that they had not been able to obtain any background regarding He stated he did not desire any information to quote, he was merely attempting to determine what kind of an individual was, that the FBI or anyone else he contacted in this regard would not be quoted.

REDDING was informed that I personally had no knowledge, it was unknown whether there was any in the office or not, that all information within the FBI files was strictly confidential; however, I would relay his request to the SAC and if there was any information or anything about that he could be told, he would be called in this regard.
