At approximately 8:55 a.m., 11/27/63, Inspector DON MOORE of the Bureau called and advised that Asst. Director VILLIAN SULLIVAN has a friend in New Orleans named who advised SULLIVAN yesterday and a Cuban name MANUEL GIL, 620 Gravier St., New Orleans, supposedly know OSWALD and OSWALD supposedly called GIL on the telephone.

/ Inspector MOORE stated GIL should be interviewed for any information he has concerning OSWALD and that they be advised by phone or teletype today of results.

I advised Mr. MOORE that one of the persons listed in the group obtaining tourists cards for travel to Merice is from Italy and MOORE said to just forget his name.
