2. Between 1215 and 1230 hours, 22 November 1963, Fort Sam Houston telephone office contacted Deputy Chief of Staff Operations and Training (DCSO&T), Hq Fourth US Army, for guidance concerning an

incoming civilian circuit telephone call to the "Silver Dollar" War Room. Fort Sam Houston telephone operator was furnished Extension No. 2703 where the unidentified caller was connected at 1225 hours, 22 November. The caller had a male voice and stated: "This is Silver Dollar calling to test communications. I read you loud and clear, loud and clear. How do you read me?" DCSO&T representative on Extension 2703 replied: "I read you loud and clear, loud and
