The smaller of the two bound sets of records could not be followed by the worksheets. Because the worksheets also have numbers added in the upper right-hand corner, I rearranged them by those numbers only to g find that there are two maked 4 and that they still do not agree with the worksheets.

As usual, the FMI went out of its way not to identify the records in its letter, so it adds to rather than reducing the confusion the FMI created deliberately. (They have written me before and I have seen many worksheets before now.)

Making it even more confusing, bound together there are the 100-10461 records, those listed as 100-10461-1 A and 1A1 and \$A2. Two are marked Vol 4 and the other three worksheets do not indicate what volume at all. Most confusing of all is the total absence of serial numbers on the attached records. Serial numbers are on the worksheets but somewhere the FBI found copies for me that do not include what is supposed to be put on each record when it is filled, the file and serial numbers.

These worksheets again are not dated. Supposed the FEI dates the worksheets when it creates them. Focause they give me a different set than they keep on file they can and often do avoid dating them. The obvious process is improper, to hide the deliberated ness with which the agreement approved by the Court is regularly violated. From internal evidence these records not maileduntil August were processed in April.

The other bound records enclosed with this 8/18 letter has the worksheets dated 7-78 (which is not the way they date their own copies). It also is a miscellaneous collection which will not be understood byscholars in the future because of the inadequate description on the worksheets.

The last record in this batch, 89-43-14-6 - 352 is described as "information provided by source." The "information" is the 247 page manuscript, "I am a Patsy, I am a Patsy," by the late George DeMohrenschildt. The "source" is not secret because he went to the press and was quoted by it after DeMohrenschildt's suicide. He is the lawyer. The usual and inappropriate 7C and D claims are made on the optering ED 340. (The FRI did not provide a copy of this with the DeMohrenschildt records.)
