This is in response to your letter of March 13, 1984, concerning "dubs of the recordings of the Dallas Police Department" allegedly maintained by the Dallas Field Office of the Federal Bureau of Investigation.

Bureau Personnel have advised me that they have informed you on several occasions that they never obtained duplicates of those tapes. Moreover, the adequacy of the Bureau's search for Kennedy Assassination records was one of the subjects of your omnibus appeal of denials of Kennedy Assassination documents maintained by the Dallas and New Orleans Field Offices. This Office has taken its final action on that appeal and the case is now in litigation. Accordingly, this matter is administratively closed.
