Oswald/Mexico City; intercepts

I have abready appealed me the withhelding under "national sequrity" claim of PMI records related to tape records of a Lee Barvey Oswald phone conversation in Mexico City. I believe I have told you that the fact of this has long been in the public domain, as it relates to electronic servial lance and to this intervept in particular. I attach other relevant records for your assistance.

The letter from Ar. Hoover to Mr. Rowley was not provided by the PRI. The best recollection I have is that the FRI still withholds this, although with the volume of records I cannot be certain. I suggest that the real reason for the centimed withholding of records that were never classified is the content of pages 4 and 5, a negative identification of Oswald by the FRI.

By appeal included a 11/23/63 teletype summarizing what Ar. Hoover here reports and a transcript provided to FRIEQ at a later date. Both records are in PRIEQ and the Dallas Field Office. Both withheld.

Movember 1976 is not the first public attention to this information. However, it the 11/26/76 Washington Post story received extraordinary play. The entire front page of the next day's Chicago Sunday paper, I think Sun-Times, was on this. The play by the Post, "ou York and Los Angeles Times are attached. He copies have been provided by the PEL, not any records relevant save for one reflecting the PEL's being informed that Kesuler was working on the story.

(Earlier reporting ranged from a detail/story by boarde Hudkins to B. Howard Bunt's account in his book of how he participated in planting devices for electronic surveillances in Fexico City embassics.)

I believe these matters have been of interest to Congressional committeess. No records relating to such interest have been provided, to the best of my recollection.

Jim Locar filed a telegraphic appeal from Wisconsin on or about 11/25/76. This and relevant seconds are included within my FA request of the Popartment as well as the FHL. (He telegraphed the AG.) He records were provided under sither the JFK or the FA requests by the Department or by FRL.

Whather the withholdings from me were designed to facilitate or perhaps not prevent further news management and the forming of official opinion and decisions may be disclosed tomorrow when the House assamine committee reportedly will hold a hearing on what includes or should include this.
