Dear Ar. Hess, Enclosed with your letter of April 7 was your originals of those letters identified as 1959. The list covering the other enclosures ends with 1938. This makes it appears that it was not your intention to enclose any version of 1959. I take these to be your originals because red taps is placed over names, which are visible to the eye as

they would not be to the machine. If you desire the return of these pages, please send me a frank addressed to the person you went to receive those pages.

I can only wonder if the Department has looked ahead from its 70 claims in this matter, about which I've writtemin the past without response. If it is to been consistent with what was done with #1865 I believe it must initiate a series of very large and costly projects.

In #1865 you withheld the address of a Congressman's office from the copy of the response to him. While the immediate purposes of the Repartment in denying the people the addresses of their elected representatives is not clear, it is clear that this withholding must be only the beginning.

Unices all other printed and published lists most and directories and withdrawn from circulation, including libraries, made and other offices and private boses, this withholding is meaningless.

And if all those lists and directories and indices are withdrawn, with what will they be replaced and at what coul? What will happen to the American who goes to one of the Houses to see any Nember? How will the guard be able to direct him? Or will he be probabiled from doing this?

In C.A. 75-1996 the Department produced Mr. Shes as an expert witness. On cross exactnation he jestified that in that historical sees ( the essessination of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr.) he testified that there had been such impunished extensive and improper use of this examption that reprocessing would be required. In this instant matter I've written often about what I believe is improper and unnecessary claims to examption, without said response. I tell you again that you people are creating unnecessary costs and problems. The one I gits is serely one of a number in the recent recerds. Another is the withholding of names that the government publishes, why do you parelet in these things?
