b7d [redacted] Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, telephonically advised that in January or February, 1963, she was with CEDRIC NORRED in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, and at that time NORRED made the statement he felt that President KENNEDY and Governor JOHN CONNALLY should both be killed. [redacted] stated NORRED made this statement during a heated discussion involving racial matters.

b7d [redacted] also said that NORRED is, in her opinion, "radical" in his actions and speech, but she did not believe him to be pro-Russian. [redacted] stated NORRED resides in Dallas, Texas, and is a representative of a furniture manufacturer located in Dallas. She was unable to furnish any information as to NORRED's address, telephone number, or the name of his employer.

b7d [redacted] has known NORRED approximately three years and has known in the past that he is familiar with night club owners and persons in the entertainment field. She had no information as to whether he was possibly associated with JACK RUBY.
