At about 3:30PM a [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] phoned saying he was calling in regard to Lee Oswald. He said he come to the U.S. 25 years ago going to New York coming to New Orleans about 24 years ago. He said while in New York he aided the New York P.D. and since the Fidel regime had aided the New York P.D. in providing information about the Fair Play Committee for Cuba and has always been a fighter against Communism.. He stated he had not known Oswald at any time and did not know specifically what Oswald's activity was in New Orleans or anywhere else in connection with Oswalds communist activity. He said he assumed Oswald had been a member of the Fair Play for Cuba organization.

[REDACTED] said what he wanted to do was to talk to an agent who was familiar with Cuban matters and explain to the agent the workings of the Fair Play Committee and go on record as saying that in his opinion such action by Oswald was not a lone wolf operation and such activity ~~was~~ was ordered by higher authority and that Oswald must have had some help. He said he had no information that this had taken place in this regard but based his opinion of his knowledge of various Cuban communist organization that operate in the U.S.

[REDACTED] said he wished to be contacted in this matter as soon as possible. He said the only person he knew who might have known Oswald was Carlos Carogga, who he said has been in contact with the FBI.
