ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT JOHN F. KENNEDY, 11/22/63, DALLAS, TEXAS

At 10:47 a.m., 11/27/63, Supervisor DAVE SMITH of the Criminal Division at the Bureau called SAC MAYNOR.

SMITH raised questions concerning the teletype submitted pertainin to DAVE FERRIE having allegedly made a statement that he thought the President should be killed and outlined a plan to bring this about.

SMITH stated he desired to know if, FERRIE, when interviewed and if JACK S. MARTIN, when he was interviewed, were specifically questioned concerning such an allegation and if twe had information this allegation had been resolved.

DAVE SMITH also stated there is some question about how OSWALD got affiliated with the Civil Air Patrol and desired to know if we had any information in this regard.

SAC MAYNOR told SMITH he would have to check our outgoing messages and 302s for information he wanted and MAYNOR would subsequently call SMITH at extension 2447 at the Bureau.

Pursuant to the above call I received various calls and was able to resolve SMITH's questions only by determining we did not have specific answers in regard to the data SMITH wants.

In view of this, at 12:05 p.m. on 11/27/63, I called Supervisor SMITH and advised we did not have an answer whether PERRIE and MARTIN were questioned in regard to alleged statement attributed to FERRIE.

I described to him how TO YOEBEL described introducing OSWALD to the CAP and the conclusion of this conversation was that New Orleans would conduct additional interviews to resolve the initial question raised by SWITH and send teletype to Bureau without fail, 11/27/63, in this regard. This teletype should also summarize OSWALD's introduction to the CAP by ED WOEBEL.  $fg_{-}/g_{-}32.5c$ .
