NOTE: Nichols made several telephonic requests for special handling in connection with the mailing of laboratory documents pertaining to the John F. Kennedy assassination case. He was furnished the charges (\$42.60) and thereafter wired a check in the amount of \$100 to the Office of the Deputy Attorney General with the request that the excess be applied to have the documents delivered to a TWA flight to Kansas City.
