I wish to advise you that as a result of a lead uncovered during the processing of records subject to a request made by Harold Weisberg, we have located a small number of records that appear to be responsive to the request of your client, Mark Allen, for Criminal Division records pertaining to the House Select Committee on Assassinations' investigation into the assassination of President John F. Kennedy. The records include the original dictabelt provided by the Dallas Police Office to the House Select Committee on Assassinations. The records were located in the office safe of Roger Cubbage, a Criminal Division attorney who was an assistant to Robert Keuch. These records are now being reviewed and a release determination will be made as soon as possible.
