Regarding your query of 6/26 about CIA surveillance of Mexico City communist embassies, I'm afraid I found nothing much. Summers, p. 373 Conspiracy (hardback), says that both the Cuban and Russian embassies were surveilled, and he cites: David Phillips speech to "National Military Intelligence Assoc., 6.76," which I don't have; and he also cites Night Watch. Summers also cites Agee, CIA Ciary pp. 542-30. Agee does say that there is surveillance of both embassies but it's not clear to me what time period he's talking about.
