New Orleans JFK Assassination Records
Clay Shaw-Ticklers

The FBI's records disclosed to Mark Allen include search slips on each of the jurors in the Clay Shaw trial of Jim Garrison.

They were in a folder identified, "Jurors - Clay Shaw Trial in N.O."

This is apparently still another tickler that was not "routinely" destroyed and it relates to information that had to originate in New Orleans.

No related New Orleans records have been disclosed to me and nothing of this sort is reflected in the disclosed Clay Shaw search records, which are not the originals but are rewritten by hand.

This still again reflects the existence of known relevant records that are not in central files, not in the so-called main files, known to the FBI to exist and neither searched for nor provided.

It is new to me and thus to you in that I have only now received copies.

These records also indicate that the FBIHQ Garrison watch was located in Room 818 of the building at 9th and D Sts., NW. I believe that part of the Criminal Division of the Department was then housed in that building and in or near rooms of this number.
