SUBJECT: Letter of March 12, 1967, from Harold Weisberg, Coq d'Or Press,  
Hyattstown, Md.

By memorandum addressed to you dated March 17, 1967, Mr. David C. Stephenson of the Office of Legal Counsel requested any information which we may have relating to the allegations in Mr. Weisberg's letter to the Attorney General concerning his inability to view certain materials associated with the assassination of President Kennedy.

One of our better Classification Clerks has made a diligent search for anything to or from Mr. Weisberg and has found nothing. I, personally, have made the second diligent search and have found nothing. Although we have carefully examined each piece of correspondence in files 129-11 and 129-012-3 as well as the restricted sections of 129-012-3, we have found no mention of any such request by Mr. Weisberg. Since his letter fails to refer to previous correspondence with this Department, perhaps his was an oral request to some individual within the Department. Record cards have been searched from 1963 to date .
