OSWALD APPARENTLY IDENTICAL WITH LEE HARVEY OSWALD,  
NOT LEE HENRY OSWALD. OTHER INFORMATION IN PARAGRAPH TWO  
RECAP ACCURATE. **u**

OSWALD RETURNED TO U.S. FROM USSR JUNE THIRTEEN, ONE NINE  
SIX TWO, WITH RUSSIAN-BORN WIFE AND DAUGHTER BORN USSR  
FEBRUARY FIFTEEN, ONE NINE SIX TWO. IN INTERVIEWS OSWALD  
HAS DENIED FURNISHING SIGNIFICANT INFORMATION TO SOVIET  
INTELL GENCE. OSWALD HAS REPORTEDLY BEEN DRINKING TO EXCESS  
AND REPORTEDLY BEAT HIS WIFE ON NUMEROUS OCCASIONS. OSWALD  
WAS ARRESTED BY NO. POLICE DEPARTMENT AUGUST NINE LAST FOR  
QUOTE DISTURBING THE PEACE AND CREATING A SCENE END QUOTE  
AT WHICH TIME HE WAS PASSING OUT LITERATURE RELATED TO QUOTE  
FAIR PLAY FOR CUBA COMMITTEE. END QUOTE. **u**

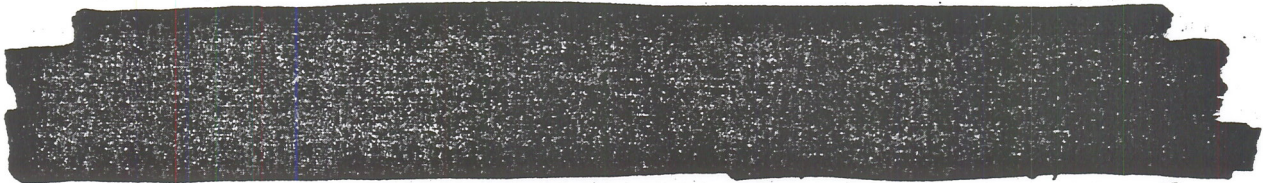
