RE: TRAVEL OF OSWALD

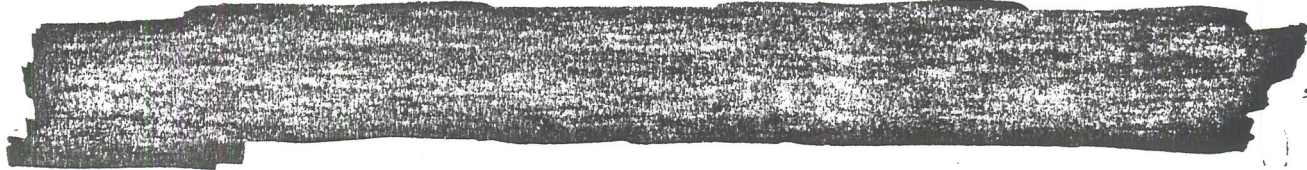
At 12:45 AM, 11/28/63, ASAC KYLE CLARK, Dallas Division, advised the Dallas Office had information that OSWALD went into Mexico via Nuevo Laredo Tampas on 9/26/63, and OSWALD was not driving. The mode of travel, whether by car or bus, was not known.

They had information from San Antonio that OSWALD came out on 10/3/63 by automobile, but do not know whether he was driving.

CLARK stated interview of Mrs. PAINE reveals she stated she had been trying to teach OSWALD to drive, and he could not even park an automobile.

Concerning Mrs. PAINE's trip to New Orleans, Mrs. PAINE kept a diary and cancelled checks which indicate she was in the Louisiana area on the night of 9/19/63, but did not arrive in New Orleans until 9/20/63.

ASAC CLARK stated a teletype was coming to New Orleans with this information and the interview of Mrs. PAINE on the AM of 11/28/63.
