On 12-5-63 [REDACTED] advised that when he was contacted by Secret Service they asked him several times if he knew anything about the address of 5th Camp St. He had been aware that this place had about a year or two ago been used by ARONHA SMITH. Afterwards he recalled that in the summer of 1963 LOUIS QUEVARA, brother of EDUARDO QUEVARA, Concrete Controls, 233 Chartres St, had used the hall on the fourth floor at 5th Camp St to exhibit office supplies. QUEVARA is strictly anti-Castro and he has no information to indicate that OSWALD might have had any connection with him or that he might have contacted him but he was merely passing this along since QUEVARA is Cuban and had been at that address for a while this past summer.
