Reference is made to your request to the Naval Intelligence Service, dated May 21, 1977, pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act. This report along with copies of Secret Service documents was received in this office on January 19, 1982.

Some information has been withheld because the documents in the requested file contain information compiled for law enforcement purposes. Pursuant to Title 5, United States Code, Section 552(b)(7)(C), the information has been exempted since disclosure would constitute an unwarranted invasion of personal privacy to other persons mentioned in the requested file. The citations of the above exemptions are not to be construed as the only exemptions which may be available under the Freedom of Information Act.
