Subsequent to our latest correspondence on the captioned subject this Division learned that the Central Intelligence Agency had placed a Top Secret classification on certain aspects of the matter. Also, it has been brought to my attention that some sensitive material may have been provided to your Bureau and other agencies on a non-classified basis. In view of this situation I have had the file reviewed to determine whether any of the materia therein should be classified. As a result of this review I have concluded that the following materials should be classified as Top Secret to comport with the Central Intelligence Agency's classification.
