
A review of the records revealed:

- (1) Two pages which are enclosed, but for excisions made pursuant to 5 U.S.C. 552 (b)(7)(C), and
- (2) Eight pages which are denied in their entirety pursuant to 5 U.S.C. 552(b)(7)(C) and (D).

You may appeal my decision in this matter, within thirty days, by writing to the Associate Attorney General, Attention: Freedom of Information Appeals Unit, Washington, D.C. 20530. The envelope and the letter should be marked "Freedom of Information Appeal." Judicial review is thereafter available either in the district in which you reside or have your principal place of business; or in the Eastern District of Louisiana; or in the District of Columbia.
