Dear Mr. Weisberg:

This is in response to your letter of July 21, 1980 concerning our partial release to you of July 17, 1980. Your administrative appeal therein is duly noted.

Since our last correspondence to you of July 17, 1980 the Criminal Division has made two more referrals to us of documents which originated in the United States Attorney's office for the Eastern District of Louisiana for review and direct response to you.

The first of these referrals consists of five documents (seven pages total) of which four pages are denied in full pursuant to 5 U.S.C. 552(b)(5) and (b)(7)(C), and three pages are released herein but for certain excisions made pursuant to 5 U.S.C. 552(b)(7)(C).

The second of these referrals consisted of a newspaper clipping released in full, a memorandum released but for a name which is excised pursuant to 5 U.S.C. 552(b)(7)(C) and nine pages denied in whole pursuant to 5 U.S.C. 550(b)(5) and (b)(7)(C).

You may appeal my decision in this matter, within thirty days, by writing to the Associate Attorney General, Attention: Freedom of Information Appeals Unit, Washington, D.C. 20530. The envelope and the letter should be marked "Freedom of Information Appeal." Judicial review is thereafter available either in the district in which you reside or have your principal place of business; or



in the Eastern District of Louisiana; or in the District of Columbia.
