FOIA Request

Dear Mr. Flanders,

In your 7/1/80 letter revoking the fee waiver that had been granted you specifically included my 5/22/80 request.

Item 7 of that request asks for all records pertaining to "Conditions and restrictions, access and distribution of what was disclosed, including duplicate copies, if any, and where, when and how deposited."

Here I further limit what this Item requests and, without prejudice to my rights to recover duplication costs, agree to pay the duplication costs.

The entire request pertains to the FBI's general releases pertaining to the assassination of President Kennedy. The quoted item pertains to any duplicate, public deposits of copies, if any.

Without regard to the other information requested in Item 7, I here request that copies of all records pertaining to the duplicate public deposits, if any, and where, when and how they were made, aside from the FBI's public reading room, be provided.
