Dear Mr. Flanders,

Enclosed is an FOIA request. I believe that because of my age, health and other factors, including the public role into which the FBI, Department and courts have forced me and the age of my earlier FOIA requests that have not yet been complied with I qualify for expedited processing, which I ask for.

Under date of 7/26 you wrote me that some (apparently not all) records relating to Thomas Tarrants were available in return for prepayment.

You treated this as a new request. It is an appeal in C.A. 75-1996, in which all charges have been waived.

In fact it is but one of a series of inter-related appeals from withholdings in that case.

Because the FBI has been about two years in getting around to this it is possible that those familiar with the matter contemporaneously are no longer assigned to your branch or were not consulted.
