You refer to the non-existence of a proposed statement by Mr. Adams regarding the Aing assessination and enclose a copy of his proposed statement relating to the JFK case.

With all due regard for those exceptional qualities that advance Fr. Adams to his present FSI position, if he did not have a prepared statement I am inclined to believe he may have found a few notes and copies of a few records would have been helpful. Given the delicate nature of some of his testimony I believe this was necessary. Would it be possible to consult Fr. Adams' recollection and files?

As I have written you in the past, the records provided from Sallas are barren on the subject matter of Sr. Adams' prepared JFE statement. The Say Grienna records, which my counsel was informed months ago were about to be sent, have not been sent. The Sallas records in question relate to a threatening note Oswald left at the DFO for SA James Patrick Hosty (recently in the headlines as stating he had "bombshells" for the House assassinations cossittee, which did not went them) and an investigation after this information was leaked. No records relating to this investigation, referred to by "r. Adams, have been provided. The New Orleans records relate to a statement made by a former Fall clerk to an unnamed lawyer. It was Mark home. This clerk, now a bank official, has been all over TV in the past year of more with the sensest story. His name is William Welter. The factual imacouracy of Mr. Adams' statement relating to the New Triesna part makes me wonder what PBIMQ did not do, perhaps did not receive from New Triesna.

With regard to the Cawald bato, as I believe I have already informed you, the POI took stammate from all those then in the DFO. Not one has been provided.

For Adams refers to that was known to me, that two witnesses gave the Warren Commission information regard this. The FBI reviewed the testimony transcripts on several levels, at different places and for a number of purposes. There is a separate Dallas file on this but no relevent records. I do not believe that the initial FBI reviewe did not let the FBI BE know, if it had not known sooner, of the note any search for which should have disclosed its destruction.

With regard to the Walter allegation Mr. Adams states what has been the FMI's public position, that it has found no teletype such as he referred to having seen about 11/17/63/ Mecance Wark Lane and Jim Carrison both believe that #146 lilies

are for gilding the semantic possibilities afforded to the FEI exceeded those it generally has no difficulty locating. There were a number of threats against the President at that time. I have written about quite a few. One of these involves the late Joseph Adams Filther, withheldings relating to whom continue in C.A.75-1996. (Has the FEI fergotten the matter of the Feckwith affidavity) Others involve the National States Rights farty, which also figures in C.A.75-1996. One of those persons also is known to have threatened Dr. Ling, I think, and did engage in racial violence.

If a distinction is made between a special communication of what is taken to be the walter description as enlarged upon by Lone and Garrison and any communication of that time relating to throats against the President the FMI ought have little difficulty finding relevant records.
