MISC - INFO CONCERNING

Reference is made to a Bureau telephone call on 11-30-63, to SA John Freeman of the New York Office relating to Mr. Russell Howland, 363 Grand Avenue, Brooklyn, New York, telephone Sterling 9-8981.

As you will recall, Mr. Howland telephonically contacted the Bureau at 1120 p.m. stating he was calling from his Brooklyn residence and stated he desired to be contacted inasmuch as he had information relating to the assassination of President Kennedy. This information indicated Howland knew the President would be assassinated three weeks prior to the occurrence.

This information was furnished to SA Freeman with instructions that Howland be contacted before 4 p.m. on 11-30-63.

New York instructed to advise date and caption of communication which furnished the Bureau and Dallas the results of this interview. Also advise if this matter has been appropriately submitted to Dallas for reporting in the above caption. Handle promptly.
