I plan to sit on it at least until Green rules on CRD in C.A. 75-1996, unless you think otherwise. (I'm worried that if we send it now, Cole will use it to take the immediate issues away from Green)

Best, I do not know what you mean by

Cole taking the immediate issues Jim away from Green. Without

knowing I can't offer an opinion. However, in general, I think that we have to take all paths to compliance that we can and make all efforts to make stonewallers face the costs of stonewalling to them, not just to us. So in this sense I

Favor filing the suits we told all at the 1977 conferences and the judge in camera that we would have to file to get compliance if they continued to avoid compliance and indulge in the dirty tricks we had played on us. I also think it would be good to make this explicit, to remind them all of that 1977 situation and that this is 1981. It might be good also to have this in the records.

I'll write separately about the request, which by and large is good. HW 2/6/81
I continue to think that the most important one may be for the emphasis index.
