Under other circumstances I would begin with a caution that the FRI, by seeing to it that those who are ignorant of what is within the public domain process the records has to saure withholding of the public domain, been identified a former informer. Of course I am letting you and through you the FBI know this. But not out of sympathy for the professional burglar Caholer, who appears to have made up a merchantable story.

His story was being retailed to the press at the time of the airtel by those the press associated with federal agencies. I was told this story at lunch with three New Orleans reporters the very day of the airtel, if my memory serves me well, at a small restaurant famous for its boiled beef and a cookbook my wife wanted me to get her. So can
I man remember it well enough. (Phonetically, May'lee's.)

Cancler appears to have been seeking a federal favor.

The only purpose served by withholding the symbol is to make it impossible to properly evaluate any other information attributed to the same symbol.

Since the time this story was fed to the press in NewOrleans in a effort to discredit Garrison, who seem eliminated all such need, it has been acknowledged by the CIA that Garrison's defendant, Shaw, had had a connection with it, a fact I published almost a decade before the CIA admission of it.

This had nothing to do with Shaw's guilt or innocence but it had much to do with what happened during the Garrison fiasco. Especially the impaired leaks of information from the federal agencies.
