ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT JOHN FITZGERALD KENNEDY, DALLAS, TEXAS, 11/22/63

January, 1967, Lyny Loisel, a member of Garrison's staff, drove him down Dauphine Street in New Orleans, and pointed out a white house with a red door. Loisel asked the source and get out without being detected. The source declined to do this. The source was told by Loisel that this had something to do with the Kennedy assassination and that the residence pointed out was that of Clay Shaw. The confidential source said he was not told what he was to do in the house or what he was to place in the house.
