INFORMATIVE NOTE

Date 4-21-67

Vernon W. Bundy testified at the hearing of Clay Shaw on 3-16-67 that he saw Shaw and Lee Harvey Oswald on the lake front in New Orleans in June or July, 1963. Bundy admitted he was a narcotics addict and was about to give himself a "fix" when he allegedly saw Shaw and Oswald.

The incident involving Lynn Loisel, a member of Garrison's staff, if true as told by the source, could indicate that Garrison is attempting to place some item in Shaw's apartment which would "frame" Shaw.
