## Chuego reards - Stepulation

King assassination records appeals: Jerry Ray and Chicago office compliance 6/26/79 with Stipulation

In connection with prior appeals I have provided a copy of a Not Recorded MURKIN FRIEQ record, a Chicago teletype of 12/12/75, containing more or less of an inventory of the Chicago Eing files.

On page three of this teletype two Subs are listed as relating to Jerry Ray.

Of these, as of 12/12/75, which is almost two years before compliance was required under the Stipulation, Sub H is described as of 31 Serials.

However, this is not what I received and I am without doubt that further records relating to Jerry May were filed subsequent to 12/12/75.

As provided to me the last Serial in Sub H is numbered 29.

Moreover, there is a skip in numbering from 22 to 27, which means I received fewer than even 29 Serials whereas the inventory species there were 29 as of 12/12/75.

This also raises questions about the affidavite filed by the Department in support of its Notion for Partial Susmary Judgement of last month.

It would also appear that some changes were made in the method of filing to hide other Jerry May records created subsequent to 12/12/75. This is to say they were filed elsewhere to defeat compliance by tricky filing.

Jerry Ray has informed me that parsuant to him, enormously more than have been provided to me from all files.

Providing copies of these records now presents no problem to the FM. It need only zerox what it has already collected. I do appeal this denial and do ask for copies of those records.

Jerry is a public figure. Moreover, personal details have already been provided.

This range from details of his personal life, the identifications of those with whom he slept to whom he was not married, an illegitimate child, his criminal record, to even the contents of his pockets and wallet. (I renew the appeal from the denial of all the results of the investigation of the notations on his person when he was arrested in Marrahda in 1960.)
