Reference is made to your letter dated July 21, 1964, inquiring as to the actual date of publication of the November 29, 1963, issue of the "Deutsche Nationalzeitung und Soldatenzeitung."

A confidential source abroad has advised that according to Gerhard Frey, Chief Editor of the "Deutsche Nationalzeitung und Soldatenzeitung," the November 29, 1963, issue of the paper was printed on November 25 and 26, 1963. According to Mr. Frey no changes were made in the text of the November 29, 1963, issue and no copies of that issue were printed after November 26, 1963.
