Attached Not Recorded Serial from 62-109090, which is also 105-82555-5199, states that FHI records were rewritten to withhold what it was believed more than 15 years ago was properly classified.

Despite the total obliteration of the note on page 2 it appears likely that the information relates to Osmeld in Review, a matter relating to which very little can today be regarded as properly classified.

The totality of the withholding violates the requirement that what is reasonably segregable be as provided.
