

JFK assassination records appeals
— Classification
Withholding the reasonably segregable

Attached Not Recorded Serial from 62-109090, which is also 105-82555-5199, states that FBI records were rewritten to withhold what it was believed more than 15 years ago was properly classified.

Despite the total obliteration of the note on page 2 it appears likely that the information relates to Oswald in Mexico, a matter relating to which very little can today be regarded as properly classified.

The totality of the withholding violates the requirement that what is reasonably segregable be ~~be~~ provided.

The record in ^{question} ~~question~~ is a summary memo. There is the information on which the summary was based.

Historically information relating to Oswald and Mexico is important and what may have appeared to be of little consequence in 1964 could, in the light of what has become known since, be significant today.
