Dear Mr. Weisberg:

This is a final response to your request pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act for records concerning the assassination of President John F. Kennedy.

We have located additional records from enclosure file 51-16-1113, as well as records contained in Department of Justice file numbered 129-012-3. Our search also reflected several documents from the Witness Records Unit and another office of the Criminal Division. The attached documents are being made available to you in full or in part. A copy of a schedule of documents is also enclosed which supplements the schedule previously furnished to you. The Freedom of Information Act exemptions which apply to the documents released in part are 5 U.S.C. 552(b):

- (5) Intra-agency correspondence which reflects the deliberative processes of the Department;
- (7) Investigatory records compiled for law enforcement the disclosure of which would:
  - (C) Constitute an unwarranted invasion of the privacy of a third party.


We have located item 558 which is being made available to you in full.

Items 970, 1939, 1962, and 1963 were referred to the Civil Rights Division for direct response to you. These documents have been referred back to us for direct response to you. These documents which are being released to you in part are subject to deletion pursuant to 5 U.S.C. 552(b)(7)(C) and 5 U.S.C. 552(b)(7)(D) (of material the release of which would reveal the identity of confidential sources or information furnished solely by confidential sources).

Item 2648 is a representative sample of approximately 7500 pages of newspaper clippings and citizen correspondence. The citizen correspondence is subject to the deletion of the names and other identifying data of the citizen correspondents. If you wish access to the newspaper clippings and citizen letters, we will make available to you copies of those records in our files at \$.10 per page.

Pursuant to Department regulations, you have a right to appeal the deletions as a partial denial of your request. This appeal must be made within thirty days in writing and addressed to the Assistant Attorney General, Office of Legal Policy (Attention: Office of Privacy and Information Appeals) United States Department of Justice, Washington, D.C. 20530. The envelope and letter should be clearly marked, "FOIPA Appeal". If on appeal your request is denied, judicial review will thereafter be available to you in the district in which you reside or have your principal place of business or the district in which the records denied to you are situated or the District of Columbia.
