Reference is made to my letter dated November 22, 1978, to you.

The New Orleans Field Office file and the Dallas Field Office file on Marina Oswald have been processed, and enclosed are 661 pages of material together with inventories. Also enclosed are 21 pages of material from the New Orleans Field Office Warren Commission file together with 206 pages of material which was located in various unrelated files of the New Orleans Office.

Some documents surfaced during processing which originated in or contained information obtained from other Governmental agencies. These documents have been referred to those agencies for a determination as to the releasability of information therein. Upon receipt of these documents, you will be advised accordingly.

We are continuing to process the Dallas Field Office special index of 5X8 cards and will be in touch with you as soon as it is completed.

You have thirty days from receipt of this letter to appeal to the Associate Attorney General from
