In your letter of 8/3 you decline further "substantive" comment relating to the unaccounted Dallas bulkies and by no mention the other parts of what I wrote.

However, you do not say or indicate that your office needs no more relevant informathon and I did make repeated reference to FMI practice.

I therefore attach copies of four "changed to" sheets from the assassination file.

As you can again sec, when there is any shifting it is the PBI's practise to record this at the point in the Sections from which the record is moved.

In this particular case it also means that JFK assassination records are being withhold by shifting to another file and that also I appeal.

This particular establishing of a new file, Beginning with Serial 1, for a JFK assassination record was in 1973. The dates of the original records are 1967.

The time of the shift is long after the FBI received FOIA requests. I therefore believe that the records should be provided and that if the FBI found need for a new and different file it should have followed its own practise of placing duplicate copies in the new file.

There are countless illustration of this practise, as copies I've sent you recently establish.

It also is not an unknown practise for the FBI to serialize these duplicate copies, although calling them "Not Recorded" is the more common practise within my experience.
