[REDACTED] furnished the following information on a confidential basis.

He stated on several occasions [REDACTED] was involved in the assassination of President Kennedy. [REDACTED] was to act as a courier delivering money to Lee Harvey Oswald after the assassination. She allegedly was present on the scene when President Kennedy was assassinated. She contends that there were other countries, terrorists involved in the shooting and that more than one individual fired shots during the assassination.

He noted [REDACTED] claimed to have been interviewed by the FBI and CIA regarding her information.

He advised [REDACTED] was definitely afraid of [REDACTED] and that he apparently was holding something over her head. She further stated to him that a murder attempt had been made on her life on the return trip from Dallas, Texas after the assassination.

[REDACTED] advised he was furnishing the above information as he did not wish to become involved in the event [REDACTED] was telling the truth and there was an ongoing investigation involving [REDACTED]
